#### PLEASE NOTE:

- Grade 12s should select a minimum of 7 courses and a maximum of 11 courses. The only way they can choose 11 courses is if one of those courses is Choral or Leadership.
- In order to graduate, students need a 20-level (Gr. 11) math and a 20-level (Gr. 11) science. However, it is important to consider the requirements of potential post-secondary programs when selecting courses for Grade 12. A total of 24 credits is required for graduation. Also, to graduate, you must have acquired a minimum of two PAA credits between grades 10 and 12, as well as a total of at least five 30-level courses.
- Please note that while we routinely provide information regarding the courses needed for graduation in Saskatchewan, parents and students need to research the requirements for entrance into specific post-secondary programs as these may be above and beyond the basic graduation requirements. Likewise, you may also book appointments with our Guidance Counsellor.
