## BCA Graduation Requirements & Course Planning Policy

All BCA courses are those prescribed by the Saskatchewan Government curricula. Because of our distinct Christian mandate, Christian Ethics is a compulsory course for students in each year that they attend BCA.

- 1. A high school diploma is earned when the student has successfully completed a minimum of 24 credits, 5 being at the Grade 12 level.
- 2. To be able to participate in BCA graduation ceremonies, the student must be on track to complete their high school diploma requirements by June 30 of the same year or have an approved plan in place to complete their missing credits. This plan must be approved by the BCA administration by April 1 of the same school year. Any exceptions to this policy will be determined by the administration.
- 3. All students are required to take at least two PAA or Fine Arts courses during their high school career. This is a requirement of the Saskatchewan Ministry of Education for all students graduating in Saskatchewan.
- 4. We routinely provide information regarding the courses needed for graduation in Saskatchewan. Parents and students should research the requirements for entrance to specific post-secondary programs as these may be above and beyond the basic graduation requirements.
